Pints for Parks: Support Flight 93 National Memorial

Shanksville, PA – April 15, 2025 – Friends of Flight 93 National Memorial invite you to join us in celebrating National Park Week, National Volunteer Week and Earth Day on **April 26, 2025**. The events planned for the day will support Flight 93 National Memorial through community engagement and fundraising.

Event Highlights:

Ranger-led Program – the day will begin at **11:30 AM at Flight 93 National Memorial flagpole** with a ranger-led program titled **“A Call to Action”**.

Guided Tour: Following this 30-minute program, a guided tour will be offered covering the **Wall of Names, the Western Overlook, the Flight path and concluding at the Visitor Center**. Throughout this event participants will learn about the aspects of the terrorist’s plan, personal stories of passengers and crew, as well as obstacles the passengers and crew overcame to thwart Flight 93 from hitting the terrorist’s target.

Pints for Parks – to be held at Forbes Trail Brewery will feature a **GIVING BACK IPA**, specifically brewed for this event, all proceeds benefitting the Resiliency Project, the rehabilitation of the 40 Memorial Groves at Flight 93 National Memorial.

- Musical entertainment by Bianca Melgar and Screaming Blonde will begin at 2 and end at 6 PM.
- Jackie’s Groovy Cheese Truck will be on-site for food purchases.
- **There is no fee to attend this event.**
